## Vancouver Catholics Holding Collection for Philippines

## Funds will provide food, water, shelter

VANCOUVER (Nov. 12, 2013) – Archbishop J. Michael is urging Catholics in the Archdiocese of Vancouver to be as generous as possible in responding to the Philippines in its moment of need.

The Archbishop has called for a special collection to be taken up at all weekend Masses Nov. 24.

The special collection is being coordinated across Canada with the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace.
